

Day 1: Arrival at the Airport in Kigali

You shall be met by our Driver/ tour guide at the Airport and transferred to Hotel. Short briefings about the tour as you make final preparations.

Overnight: Flame tree Hotel (Bed & Breakfast)

Day 2: Transfer to Akagera National Park and Boat Ride

In the morning, head out on a scenic drive to Akagera National Park arriving early for lunch at Akagera Game Lodge.

After lunch, go for afternoon boat cruise on Lake Ihema and expect to see hippos, crocodiles and lots of water birds.

Overnight: Akagera Game Lodge (Full Board)

Day 3: Full Day Game drives

Early morning and with packed lunch, you will go for a game drive up to the northern part of the park to catch up with early risers before they go into hiding. Expect to see lions, antelopes, giraffes, bush bucks among others. (Akagera N P is home to the Big Five).

Overnight: Akagera Game Lodge (Full Board)

Day 4: Game Drives and Imigongo Tours

Re-enter the park for another half day game drive with packed lunch, thereafter proceed to visit the Imigongo arts (decorating houses using cow dungs and is usually produced by women. The dung is dried and mixed with colors made from organic material like plants to create mostly white, Black and red paints.

Overnight: Karenge Bush Camp(Full Board).


Day 5: Transfer to Volcanoes National Park & Genocide Memorial

The mountain views are magnificent as you head towards the Great Rift Valley and Nakuru National Park. There are plenty of animals including Rhinos, Leopards and Giraffes as well as large numbers of Flamingos that turn the shoreline pink. We will then head to Lake Naivasha Country Club for dinner and overnight (Full Board).

Day 6: Diana Fossy Memorial Hike and Cultural Tour

We will head for the Diane Fossey center 3 -4 hrs walk, taking us through the history of the research center and its benefits to the community.

On return if time allows you can go for a nature walk/ sightseeing or visit the local communities or cultural center where you will be told stories about Rwandese and also enjoy their cultural dances. Dinner and Overnight at **Le Bambou Gorilla lodge (Full Board)**

Day 7: Golden Monkey trek/Optional activities

This day, you will either go for golden monkey tracking or go for Dian Fossey hike at Karisoke research centre, where Dian, an American anthropologist spent years researching and conserving the gorillas before she was killed and buried next to Digit, a silverback gorilla.


Have lunch at your lodge late in the afternoon undertake a nature walk near the volcanoes national park or either visit the visit of lby'lwacu Cultural Village

Overnight Le Bambou Lodge (Full Board)

Day 8: Drive to Nyungwe Forest and Canopy Walk.

After breakfast drive alongside Lake Kivu to the Magnificent Nyungwe Forest. The road is scenic and offers a panoramic view of the lake and hills and on arrival check in, have lunch and in the evening do a canopy walk – enjoy the beautiful sights and sounds of different bird species such as the Rwenzori Turacos, Hornbills among others.

Dinner and Overnight at Gisakura Guest House (Full Board)





Day 9: Coffee and Tea Plantation Tour and Lake Kivu

After breakfast drive to the Northern part town of Rubavu, en route visit the coffee and tea plantations, on arrival check into your hotel, have lunch then afternoon optional boat ride to explore nearby Islands on Lake Kivu.

Dinner and Overnight at Rwiza Village Guest House (Full Board)
